LIST OF ACCEPTABLE FORMS FOR PROOF OF IRS NUMBERS

Note that Customs has emphatically stated that they will only accept IRS forms which were *created by the IRS* (rather than forms which were submitted by the importer to the IRS) as proof of a federal taxpayer identification number.

List of Acceptable Forms:

- Form 147C: Verification of EIN
- SS4 Letter
 - Must be copy received from IRS, not the application form which was sent by importer to the IRS
 - May take the form of a “Tele-Tin” or “Fax-Tin” form
 - Form 8109/8109C: Quarterly Tax Deposit Coupons (preprinted by IRS)
 - Any fax verification form from the IRS

The following documents are *not* acceptable:

- Federal Income Tax Returns
- SS4 Application
- W-9
- All State Forms
